RENTALS



First, there are several hotels across the island, both on the ocean side and the bay side. Rooms on the ocean side will be more costly, but some allow visitors to overlook the ocean and boardwalk at night. Some also have rooms for rent with balconies that overlook the ocean. Others are farther back, but still within walking distance of the boardwalk for shopping and late night eating. Most hotels have a swimming pool available for families with little children. For those on more of a budget, there are hotels on the bay side which offer cheaper overnight stays. However, those that stay there will have to drive over to the ocean and boardwalk and pay daily parking. It is recommended to reserve in advance.

There are also several hundred houses to rent close to the ocean, but these need to be rented months in advance of the summer season. Most houses are two or three stories, and a family or extended family can rent one level. If many people want to go, both levels of the house can be rented together, but this is more difficult to get. Most of the houses for rent are down on streets farther from boardwalk shopping, so is more of a walk to get to the shops and food. However, they all have their own kitchens so that meals can be prepared inside. Rentals quickly get taken, so it is important to book a house several months or up to a year before the vacation starts. Otherwise, only hotels will remain.

A typical day in Ocean City starts with a sunrise over the ocean. Start the day by visiting one of many local restaurants for breakfast. Rent a bike or Seri to ride down the boardwalk during the morning hours when shops are not open. After the morning is over, take a beach chair and umbrella up to the beach and relax on the sand, or go swimming in the ocean. As the sun sets, go back to your lodge and prepare a meal yourself, get a quick bite to eat on the boardwalk, or dine in at one of many fancier restaurants. The night offers several activities on the boardwalk, including go karts, mini golf, amusement rides, or just shopping the night away in hundreds of stores for many souvenirs.



Several churches on the island offer Sunday services for those who do not want to miss worship when they are on vacation. There are a variety of demoninations and most accept the standard of dressing down as most don't pack dress clothes. There are several boats which offer daily fishing trips and whale watches. The more adventurous can sign up to go parasailing where you hang in the air over open water on a type of hot air ballon as a boat pulls forward. Several specialty shopes are available down the different streets of the city which offer specialized pet foods and toys, sourveniers, kitchen utensils, and other merchandise not on the boardwalk.
